Sales News

Echuca CIH has been a leader in the provision of Precision Farming since 1999, when they first provided visual guidance for a tractor in a seeding application. The first hydraulic steering using an RTK signal was sold and installed in 2001. By 2002 we were selling and installing seed rate control on air seeders and wing cut off on sprayers. During the next 10 years, the Case IH AFS Accuguide products have been developed in partnership with global leader Trimble. Echuca CIH guidance network covers an extensive area of northern Victoria and Southern NSW. We have been committed over the last few years in building a GPS network guidance signal to many different locations. Phil Kennaugh is our guidance guru who has helped in establishing this network as well as installing the base stations and repeaters in all the locations. We currently have an RTK signal covering over 8,000sqKm. We plan to extend this area as demand grows. Phil also heads up the sales and installation of the guidance packages that we provide. We have a range of packages available from the basic light bar models to the RTK hydraulic steering. We can also cater for implement steering which steers the implement independent of the tractor to provide straight bed forming or allow for inter-row sowing. We are also pleased to announce that we can now provide TRIMBLE FIELD LEVEL 2. This new GPS system is for laser grading and land forming. This system alleviates the need for a tower and laser transmitter in the paddock, it operates off our network signal or your base station to allow you to set up for irrigation or put in drainage channels. We are one of only four Case IH Dealers in Australia to be authorised to sell this system.
